We are particularly pleased that Dean Mnookin has a strong history with and commitment to shared governance and look forward to working with her to ensure UW-Madison remains a world-class institution as we move through the 21st Century.

PROFS also commends Professor Susan Hagness for helping lead an effective search and screen committee, and thanks all the members of the committee for their work.
